=Abstract=

The speaker examines how China's soft-power diplomacy has caused a dramatic improvement in Philippine-China relations that has been unthinkable ten years ago. He observes that bilateral trade and investment relations have increased significantly, at the same time, both countries are also conducting close and intense security cooperation since 2005. He notes that such developments in the bilateral relations have been initiated by China in its pursuit of its changing strategic interests in Southeast Asia. In conclusion that the general improvement in Philippine-China bilateral relations is part and parcel, he argues of China's overall diplomatic efforts to shape the Southeast Asian view of its emergence and to apply soft power in an effort to erode American strategic preponderance and influence in the region.
