Notice regarding the installation of earthquake warning devices

Devices providing emergency notices of earthquakes have been installed at Nanzan University to ensure the safety of our students and to help prevent damage caused by earthquakes. Only a few seconds of prior warning can be given before a strong tremor, so we need to be mentally prepared to take appropriate action in that short time to protect ourselves from harm.

1. What to do if you hear or see an earthquake warning

- (1) When you hear an earthquake warning, your personal safety must be your first priority.
- ⊙ Do not panic and run outside if you are inside a classroom or dining room, instead protect your head by seeking shelter under a desk in preparation for the tremor.
 - ⊙ If you are in a gymnasium, hallway or on a staircase and there is nowhere readily available for you to take shelter from falling objects, watch out for falling glass or other objects and get ready for the tremors.
 - ⊙ Move away from shelves if you are in library or similar room.
 - ⊙ If you are outdoors, move away from buildings and get ready for the tremors.
 - ⊙ If you are in the pool, get out immediately and get ready for the tremors. Be particularly wary of falling glass from either side of the pool.
- (2) Once the tremors have stopped, follow the designated path and assemble in the evacuation area.
- ⊙ If the warning is given during class time, teaching staff will guide students out of the classroom to the evacuation area.
- (3) After evacuating and confirming that everyone is safe, please wait at the evacuation area until the Disaster Countermeasure Office issues further instructions.
- ⊙ Wait for instructions concerning classes recommencing, being cancelled or for students to return home.

Please check material provided separately to confirm your understanding of evacuation routes and evacuation areas for each campus.

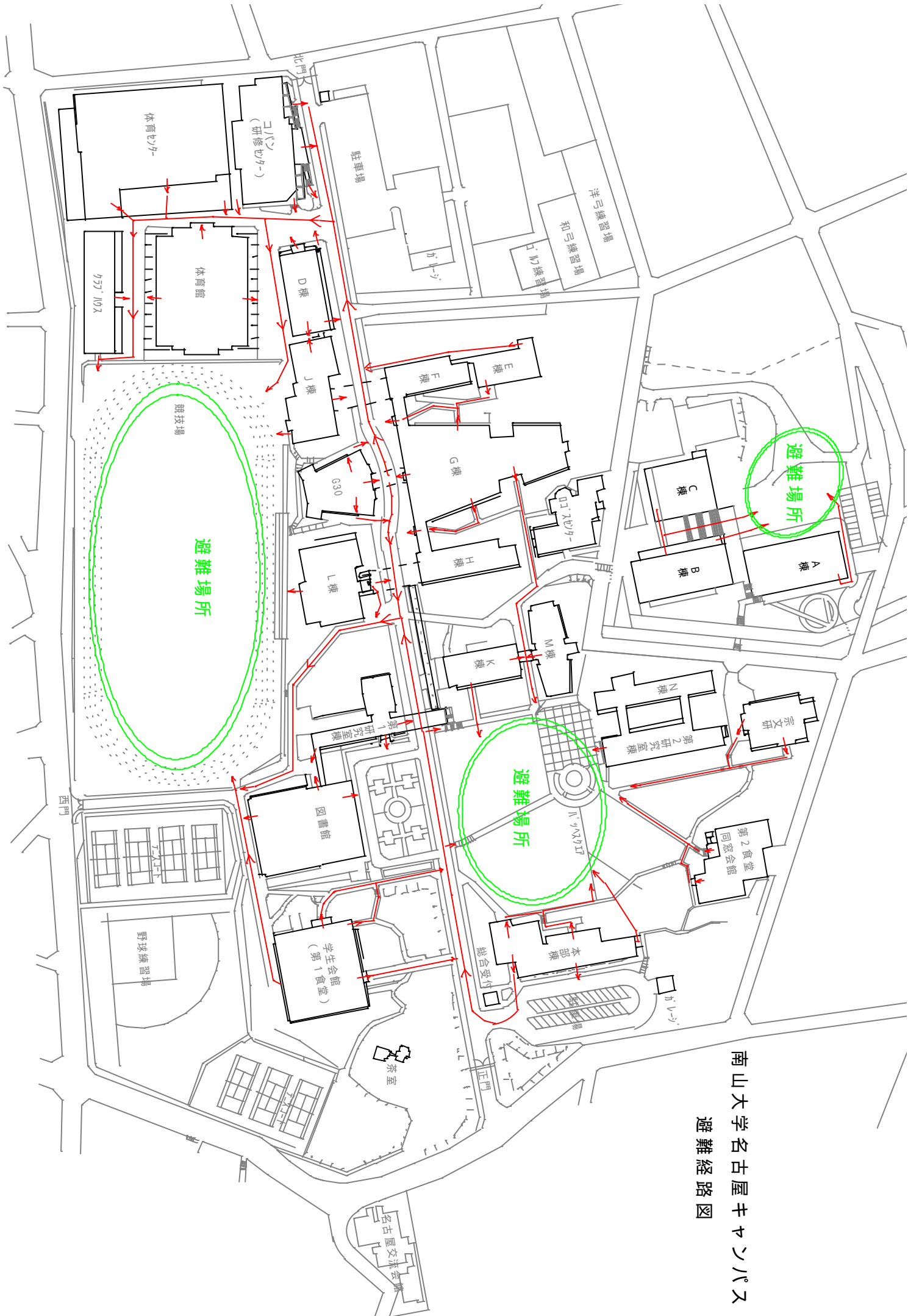

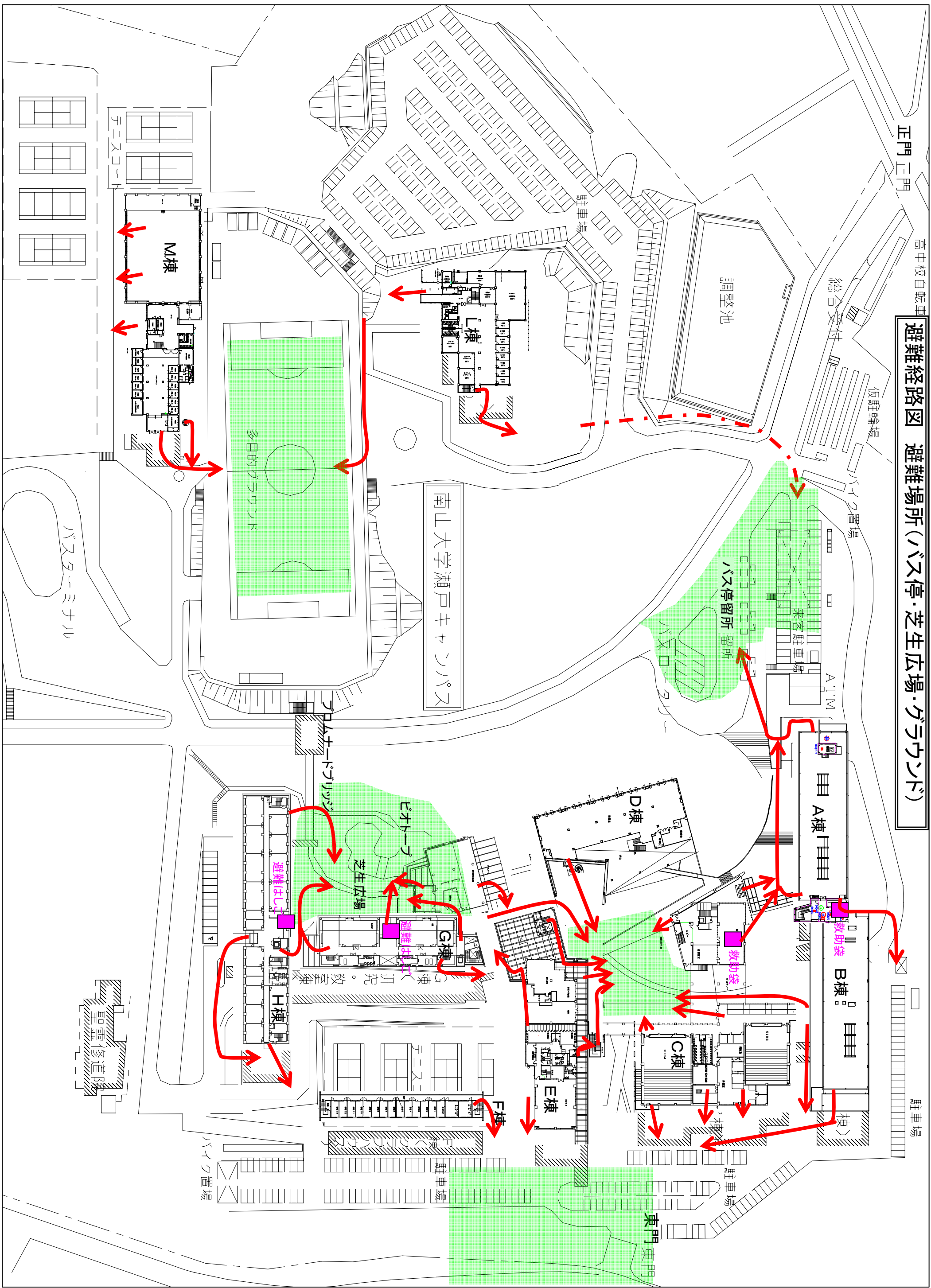
